오다 (to come) : 와요(come) – 왔어요(came) – 올 거예요(will come)

자다 (to sleep) : 자요(sleep) – 잤어요(slept) – 잘 거예요(will sleep)

보다 (to watch) : 봐요(see) – 봤어요(saw) – 볼 거예요(will see)

모르다 (to not know) : 몰라요(don't know) – 몰랐어요 (didn't now)– 모를 거예요 (will not know)

알다 (to know) : 알아요(know) – 알았어요(knew) – 알 거예요 (will know)

살다(to live): 살아요(live) – 살았어요(lived) – 살 거예요(will live)

전화하다: (to call) : 전화해요(call) – 전화했어요(called) – 전화할 거예요(will call)

말하다: (to speak/say/tell) 말해요(say) – 말했어요(said) – 말할 거예요(will say)

가다: (to go) : 가요(go) – 갔어요(went) – 갈 거예요(will go)

만나다: (to meet) : 만나요(meet) – 만났어요(met) – 만날 거예요(will meet)

기다리다: (to wait) : 기다려요(wait) – 기다렸어요(waited) - 기다릴 거예요(will wait)

마시다: (to drink) : 마셔요(drink) – 마셨어요(drunk) – 마실 거예요 (will drink)

배(가) 고프다: (to be hungry) 배가 고파요(hungry) – 배가 고팠어요(was hungry)
– 배 고플 거예요(will be hungry) / 배: stomach

아프다: (to be sick) 아파요 (is sick) – 아팠어요 (was sick) – 아플 거예요 (will be sick)

바쁘다: (to be busy) 바빠요 (is busy) – 바빴어요 (was busy) – 바쁠 거예요 (will be busy)

치다: (to hit) 쳐요 (hit) – 쳤어요(hit) – 칠 거예요(will hit)

사다: (to buy) 사요 (buy) – 샀어요 (bought) – 살 거예요 (will buy)

비싸다: (to be expensive) 비싸요(is expensive) – 비쌌어요(was expensive) – 비쌀 거예요(will be expensive)

만들다: (to make) 만들어요(make) – 만들었어요(made) – 만들 거예요(will make)

주다: (to give) 줘요(give) – 줬어요(gave) – 줄 거예요(will give)

멈추다: (to stop) : 멈춰요(stop) – 멈췄어요 (stopped) - 멈출 거예요 (will stop)
