

#1. 지금은 저녁 시간이에요. 오늘 점심을 너무 많이 먹었어요. 배가 안 고파요. 지금 저녁을 먹고 싶지 않아요. 앞으로 점심을 많이 먹지 않을 거예요.

(It's dinner time now. I had too much lunch today. I am not hungry. I won't have too much lunch from now on.)

앞으로: from now on

What is NOT correct according to the dialogue?

1) I had too much lunch.

2) I am not hungry.

3) I want to have dinner soon. (The speaker said "I do not want to have dinner now.")

4) I won't eat too much lunch from now on.

#2.

여자: 요즘 김 선생님의 수업을 듣고 있어요. 진짜 좋아요.

남자: 지수 씨도 그 분을 알아요?

여자: 당연하죠. 누가 몰라요?

남자: 저는 작년까지 몰랐어요. 그 선생님의 수업을 언제 들어요?

여자: 저는 월요일이랑 수요일마다 두 시간씩 들어요.

(Woman: I am taking Teacher Kim's class these days. It's really good.

Man: You (=지수 씨) know him(=그 분) too?

Woman: Of course. Who doesn't know (him)?

Man: I didn't know till last year. When do you take his/her class?

Woman: Monday and Wednesday, two hours each.)

2-1. **What can be inferred from the dialogue?**

1) **The woman's name is Jisoo.**

2) Teacher Kim is not well-known.

3) The man is busy on the weekend.

2-2. **When does the woman take Teacher Kim's classes?**

1) Every Tuesday and Thursday

2) Every Monday and Wednesday

3) Every day for two hours

4) Twice a day

#3.

오늘은 토요일이에요. 저는 주말마다 친구들이랑 영화관에서 영화를 봐요. 저번 주말에는 슬픈 영화를 봤어요. 많이 울었어요. 오늘도 영화관에 왔어요. 영화관에 사람이 많아요. 오늘은 액션 영화를 볼 거예요. 다음 주에는 웃긴 영화를 볼 거예요. 많이 웃고 싶어요.

(Today is Saturday. Every weekend, I watch movies with my friends in the movie theatre. Last weekend, I watched a sad movie. I cried a lot. I came to the movie theater today as well. There are many people here. Today I'll watch an action movie. Next week I'll watch a funny movie. I want to laugh a lot.)

3-1. 오늘은 주말인가요? Is it weekend today? **네** / 아니요

3-2. 평일마다 영화를 보나요? Does the speaker watch movie every weekday? **네** / **아니요**

3-3. 어디에서 영화를 보나요? Where do you watch the movie? **영화관** (movie theatre)

3-4. 슬픈 영화를 언제 봤나요? When did you watch the sad movie? **저번 주말** / 어제 / 오늘

3-5. 다음 주에는 액션 영화를 볼 건가요? Will you watch action film next week?

1) 네, 맞습니다. Yes, that is correct.

2) 아니요, 이미 저번 주에 봤습니다. No, she watched it already last week.

3) 아니요, 다음 주에는 웃긴 영화를 볼 겁니다. No she will watch a funny movie next week.

3-6. What is INCORRECT?

1) 여자는 저번 주말에 많이 울었습니다. The woman cried a lot last weekend.

2) 영화관에 사람이 적습니다. ~~There aren't many people in the movie theatre.~~ [적다: to be small [in number, amount] <> 많다] (The speaker said, "영화관에 사람이 많아요.")

3) 여자는 많이 웃고 싶습니다. The woman wants to laugh a lot.
