**['ㅂ' 불규칙]**

This coffee is cold.

It was cold yesterday.

Kimchi is not spicy.

Jisoo's hair is soft.

Tomorrow will be hot.

I caught the fish.

I will wear this dress tomorrow.

### **['ㄷ' 불규칙]**

I listen to the music every day.

I closed the door.

I walked for 2 hours.

I received a gift from mom.

### **['ㅎ' 불규칙]**

The sky is blue.

Jisoo's face is red.



The cat is white.

My skin is dark.

I am always like this.

What is that man (acting) like that?

How was it?

My sister gave birth to a twin.

**['ㅅ' 불규칙]**

Jisoo quickly got better.

I cried last night so my eyes swelled.

Stir the coffee for 5 seconds.

That company built this building.

Jisoo smiles often.

## **['ㅡ' 불규칙]**

I write novels. 저는 소설을 써요.

This coffee is bitter. 이 커피는 써요.

I turned off the light. 저는 불을 껐어요.

Mom is busy on the weekend. 엄마는 주말에 바빠요.

I was too hungry. 저는 너무 배(가) 고팠어요.

I was happy to see Jisoo. 지수를 봐서 기뻐했어요.

## **['르' 불규칙]**

Korean and English are different. 한국어랑 영어는 달라요.

Airplanes are faster than trains. 비행기는 기차보다 더 빨라요.

I cut my hair yesterday. (=I had a haircut.) 어제 머리를 잘랐어요.

I am lazy. 저는 게을러요.

I didn't know that word. 그 단어를 몰랐어요.

I didn't choose yet. 아직 안 골랐어요.

### **['ㄹ' 불규칙]**

I will live in Korea next year. 내년에(=다음 해에) 한국에(or 한국에서) 살 거예요.

I made a necklace. 목걸이를 만들었어요.

Seoul is far from Busan. 서울은 부산에서(=부산으로부터) 멀어요.

Jisoo earned a lot of money. 지수는 돈을 많이 벌었어요.

I will hang out with Jisoo on Saturday. 지수랑 토요일에 놀 거예요.

Jisoo will(may) know. 지수는 (아마) 알 거예요.

**['ㅂ' 불규칙]**

This coffee is cold. 이 커피는 차가워요.

It was cold yesterday. 어제 추웠어요.

Kimchi is not spicy. 김치는 안 매워요.

Jisoo's hair is soft. 지수의 머리는 부드러워요.

Tomorrow will be hot. 내일 더울 거예요.

I caught the fish. 물고기를 잡았어요.

I will wear this dress tomorrow. 내일 이 드레스를 입을 거예요.

**['ㄷ' 불규칙]**

I listen to the music every day. 저는 매일 음악을 들어요.

I closed the door. 문을 닫았어요.

I walked for 2 hours.

2시간 동안 걸었어요.

I received a gift from mom.

엄마한테 선물을 받았어요.

### **['ㅎ' 불규칙]**

The sky is blue.

하늘이 파래요.

Jisoo's face is red.

지수의 얼굴이 빨개요.

The cat is white.

고양이가 하얘요.

My skin is dark.

제 피부는 까매요.

I am always like this.

저는 항상 이래요.

What is that man (acting) like that? (What's with that man?)

그 남자 왜 그래요? / 저 남자 왜 저래요?

How was it?

어때요?

My sister gave birth to a twin.

언니(or 누나)가 쌍둥이를 낳았어요.

### ['ㅅ' 불규칙]

Jisoo quickly got better.

지수가 빨리(=금방) 나았어요.

I cried last night so my eyes swelled.

어젯 밤에 많이 울어서 눈이 부었어요.

Stir the coffee for 5 seconds.

5초동안 커피를 저어요.

That company built this building.

그 회사가 이 건물을 지었어요.

Jisoo smiles often.

지수는 자주 웃어요.

**\*Side Note** : Please don't worry too much about whether to use "이/가" or "은/는" (subject markers) in these sentences~ In homework like this, one sentence usually lacks context, so it's fine to use either one ☺
